

#### **Efforts to Combat Robocalls Show Progress**

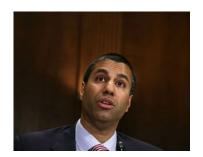
The industry-led Robocall Strike Force submitted a report to the Federal Communications
